CIIM MSc in Financial Services aims to prepare participants to tackle demanding financial or banking jobs by helping them acquire theoretical and practical knowledge regarding recent and important developments in the sector. Students will also be able to specialise in the field of their choice (financial services, banking or insurance management), do an internship with a reputable company, or work on a finance-related thesis.

Given the recent changes that have occured in the financial industry in Cyprus and Europe, the programme is structured to reflect the actual needs of the local and international financial market. Furthermore, our MSc helps participants to develop an analytical understanding of modern finance and accrue decision-making and management skills that are needed in a challenging business environment.

The MSc in Financial Services is part of the CFA University Affiliation Programme. Furthermore, the programme positions students well to obtain the Chartered Financial Analyst designation, which has become the most respected and recognised investment credential in the world. The CIIM Executive Education department offers further preparatory seminars dedicated to these exams as well as other finance-related programmes and activities.

## **Programme Details**

#### **COMPOSITION**

The MSc in Financial Services requires that students complete 90 ECTS credits as follows:

- Earn 60 ECTS from taught core courses
- Earn 30 ECTS from one of the following options:
  - Specialisation elective courses
  - Elective courses without a specialisation
  - A 15,000+ word Final Project (Thesis)

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

We seek to select highly qualified candidates who are motivated, who desire to affect positive change to their organisation and who will make a positive contribution at CIIM.

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited programme.
- Proficiency in English (graduation from an English speaking institution, TOEFL, IELTS or similar standardised test).
- Successful personal interview.

### TIME AND DURATION

The MSc in Financial Services is a flexible modular programme with rolling admissions, which means you can join any time of the year. However, we generally have two main intakes of students, one in September/October and another in January/February.

Classes are held during evenings and weekends, leaving weekdays free for employment or an internship.

The MSc in Financial Services can be completed in one year by attending classes six-to-eight evenings plus one weekend per month, or you can complete it at a slower pace taking up to a maximum of two years.

- Use financial modelling techniques to value assets, projects and companies
- Apply the use of options, futures, forwards, swaps and other derivatives to manage risk in a domestic and international setting
- Employ capital budgeting techniques to evaluate projects

- Construct a diversified asset portfolio
- Prepare company's financial statements
- Apply empirical methods to analyse financial data
